

Cabin Rules

The golden rule for visitors to our cabins is to leave the cabin in the same condition as you would wish to find it, and preferably even better.

- **Sign in:** Everyone must sign the guestbook, providing at least their name and the date of the visit.
- **Safety:** Introduce yourself to fire instructions, inform yourself about emergency exits, fire extinguishing equipment and the use of gas flares.
- **Safety:** Check that the smoke detector is in place and functioning correctly.
- **Candle:** Be careful when using candles.
- **Dogs:** Dogs are permitted, but they are not allowed on beds, sofas, or chairs.
- **Cleaning:** The cabin and its inventory must be properly cleaned before departure.
- **Dishes:** Wash all items used and return them to their proper place.
- **Firewood:** Use the wood stove responsibly and refill the woodbox before leaving. Transporting firewood to these cabins is expensive.
- **Gas:** The gas stove is for cooking only, not for heating. Ensure the gas valve is closed upon departure.
- **Waste:** Take all trash, recyclables, and food scraps with you when you leave.
- **Water:** Empty all water buckets.
- **Shutters:** If the window shutters were closed when you arrived, they must be closed and securely fastened when you leave.
- **Toilet:** Ensure the outhouse door is properly closed and locked.
- **Ash:** Do not empty the stove or fireplace before departure. Hot ash is a fire hazard.
- **Ventilation:** During winter, all air vents must be closed.
- **Maintenance:** Please notify the mountain board office (*fjellstyrekontoret*) if anything is missing or damaged, or if the cabin was not properly cleaned upon your arrival.

If you have used a boat, ensure it is properly pulled up and securely moored.
